4. Health Insurance Plan for the City of Arcadia

City Administrator advised Council that he held a meeting for all employees and retirees regarding health insurance and a few gave written comments relative to which insurance company they preferred. Dr. Miller emphasized that he had no personal preference and his only criteria is what would benefit the City and its employees most in the short and long term regarding health insurance. Councilmember Craven asked

valuable employee due to harassment that happened in the past and she advised Dr. Miller that he had witnessed the incident. Dr. Miller responded that the incident occurred after the employee had already given her resignation and that he was not present during the entire exchange, however from what he heard it was not acrimonious between the parties involved in the incident.

There was additional discussion regarding the health insurance issue. Dr. Miller stated that he was acting in good faith in the best interest of the City. He emphasized that Mrs. Jankosky is intelligent and always professional and he has wanted to sit down with her to discuss job duties. Councilwoman Craven called for a vote on the motion. **The motion failed 3-2 with voting as follows: Councilwoman Craven, Yes; Mayor Heine, Yes; Deputy Mayor Keene, No; Dr. Johnson, No; Dr. Goodman, No.**
